#### **CARTAGENA**

Known as the Heroic, Cartagena de Indias is a city full of history in its streets and dwellers. Founded in 1533 by the Spaniard Don Pedro de Heredia, it was once the most important port of the Americas.

Its excellent location and military fort made a safe haven for treasures and wealth of the Spanish Crown. A majestic fence of walls and forts was built around it to defend it from constant pirate attacks, and now frames the history of a colonial city.

Its historic downtown, known as Corralito de Piedras, is filled with houses and balconies displaying the architecture of a Spanish villa in Colonial times.

UNESCO declared it a World Heritage Center because it is a city full of history.

Cartagena de Indias was the first province to become independent from the Spanish Crown on November 11, 1811. This date is remembered and celebrated as Independence day.

#### **AIRPORT**

Cartagena de Indias' International Airport Rafael Nuñez dis located only 15 minutes away from the touristic/hotel area and 10 minutes from the walled city. It receives direct flights from Madrid, Spain, Miami, Florida, Bogotá, Medellin and many other international destinations.

It has a runway of 2600 meters at sea level with sufficient capacity for modern transatlantic airplanes to operate without problems.

It has parking capacity for 11 airplanes in platform as well as an open sky policy for charter flights.





#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

Transcaribe, (Integrated Transportation System of the District of Cartagena de Indias) is currently under construction and shall change the city's urban landscape drastically. It is based on a Bus Rapid Transit system where mid-size buses transport users to transfer terminals, where main routes consisting of large articulated buses circulate through bus/preferential lanes, bringing users to their final destinations.
